The Four Seasons (Italian: *Le quattro stagioni*) is a group of four concerti grossi by Italian composer Antonio Vivaldi, each of which gives musical expression to a season of the year. They were written around 1716-1717 and were published in 1725 in Amsterdam, together with eight additional concerti grossi, as *Il cimento dell'armonia e dell'invenzione* ("The Contest Between Harmony and Invention"). Antonio Lucio Vivaldi (Italian: [anˈtʰɔːnjo ˈluːtʰo viˈvaldi]; 4 March 1678 – 28 July 1741) was an Italian Baroque musical composer, virtuoso violinist, teacher, and priest. Born in Venice, the capital of the Venetian Republic, he is regarded as one of the greatest Baroque composers, and his influence during his lifetime was widespread across Europe.
