Missing Treasures. Over the centuries California has gathered a large list of lost gold mines, buried treasure chests, and sunken ships.. Some are mines that were lost and never found again; prospectors told their story around campfires and many an expedition to find these lost mines never returned, swallowed up by the harsh climate of certain regions of California. The above coins may or may not have come from a cache made by 4 outlaws who robbed the Sante Fe train in 1889, 34 miles E of Flagstaff. The loot was taken up Canyon Diablo to a cedar thicket where the spendable loot was divided and the diamond jewelry and separated rifles and watches buried on the rim. \$40,000 in gold coins are buried in a cave near Castella. California outlaw Joaquin Murrieta buried \$175,000 between Burney and Hatcher Mountain Pass not far from Hwy. 299.
