

Download Revised Form 990 A Line By Line Preparation Guide

As of the 2018 tax year, Form 1040, U.S. Individual Income Tax Return, is the only form used for personal (individual) federal income tax returns filed with the IRS. In prior years, it had been one of three forms (1040 [the "Long Form"], 1040A [the "Short Form"] and 1040EZ - see below for explanations of each) used for such returns. Change to Schedule B (reporting of donor information). A tax-exempt organization, other than a section 501(c)(3) organization (including a section 4947(a)(1) nonexempt charitable trust) or a section 527 political organization, is no longer required to report the names and address of its contributors on the Schedule B (Schedule of Contributors) attached to its Form 990 or Form 990-EZ for tax ...Future Developments. Information about any future developments affecting Form 990-T (such as legislation enacted after we release it) will be posted on that page. After having several discussions with the IRS, our PTO decided to hire a tax preparation service to file our 990 EZ.
